Vincent Patrick Halloran, 92, of Easton, MD, died on Friday, May 1, 2015, at Bayleigh Chase in Easton. He was born on December 2, 1922, in Cleveland, OH, son of the late James Halloran and Anna Frances Connor Halloran.

Mr. Halloran served in the United States Army from 1943 – 1946. He also served for 10 years as a civilian in the Far East Command, Dept. of Defense. He attended Benjamin Franklin High School in New York, The University of Delaware, Sophia University in Tokyo, and The University of California. He also received education from the Department of Agriculture. Mr. Halloran was employed as a Program Analyst with the FAA for 36 years. He was a member of Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Easton, A.O.A, Knights of Columbus, and I.E.E.E.

He is survived by his wife of 42 years, Marie Halloran; a daughter, Terri Halloran; a son, Tony Halloran; a daughter-in-law, Elissa; two grandchildren, Kieran and Meara; a brother, Thomas Halloran; sister-in-law, Kitty; a brother, Bernard Halloran; a sister-in-law, Ann; a sister-in-law, Vicky Halloran; and several nieces and nephews.
