Vincent Mazzola, 75, of Easton, MD, died on Wednesday, February 19, 2014, at the University Of Maryland Shore Medical Center in Easton. He was born in Brooklyn, NY, on October 4, 1938, son of the late John B. Mazzola and Catherine Finazzio Mazzola.
