Viola Lillian Barry Cannon of Centreville died at her home on Thursday, April 18, 2002. She was 76.

Born October 25, 1925 in Baltimore, MD, she was the daughter of the late Roland Pennington and Lillian Mary Smith Barry. After attending school in Baltimore City she married Charles Daniel Cannon on October 24, 1943. During World War II she worked for the C & P Telephone Company as an operator. Following her husband's return from the war they moved to the Eastern Shore of Maryland where she was a homemaker. She resided in Centreville for the majority of her life. Mr. Cannon died on December 16, 1992.
