Violet L. Gawel of Easton, MD died on Saturday, April 12, 2008 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. She was 87.

Born July 27, 1920 in Woodlawn, MD, she was the daughter of the late August J. and Helen Borgmann Luers. She was a 1937 she graduate of Catonsville High School. While living in the Baltimore area she worked for the V.P. Greenwood Nursery School and as office manager at Ideal Pictures. She moved to Neavitt, MD in 1974 where she remained until moving to Easton in 2004.

Her husband William A. Gawel, Sr., whom she married September 10, 1938 in Winchester, VA, died in 1990.

and-nephews; and many great-great-nieces-and-nephews. She was predeceased by one brother, Wilbur Luers; a sister, Thelma Becker; and sister-in-law, Eileen Luers.
