



## Virginia I. E. Albert

February 11, 1942 - September 20, 2014

Virginia Inés Albert, 72, passed away peacefully on Saturday, September 20, 2014, with her children by her side. Born February 11, 1942, in Olivos, Argentina, she was the daughter of Inés (Firpo) and Miguel Estévez.

Educated at the British School in Buenos Aires, she learned English as a youth. At the age of 21, she immigrated to the United States, entering at New York, and became a naturalized citizen in 1981. In 1967, she married Charles Barry Albert. They lived in King of Prussia, PA, and later settled in Malvern, PA. In 2005, they moved to St. Michaels, MD.

She worked as a personal accountant, and more recently, as a court interpreter in Talbot, Caroline, and Dorchester Counties. An avid sailor, tennis player, and gardener, Virginia enjoyed the outdoors. She sailed on the Chesapeake Bay with her family in a series of boats, the last of which was her Bermuda 40 yawl Esperanza. Virginia was a member of the Cruising Sailors of St. Michaels, the Herring Island Sailing Fleet, the Chesapeake Bay Bermuda 40 Association, and the Miles River Yacht Club, where she actively supported the Veterans and Junior Sail programs.

Her husband, Barry, died in 2010. Virginia is survived by a sister, Margarita Capurro (Carlos) of Santa Rosa, CA.; her children, Mariana Inés Albert Leshner (Pete) of Easton, MD, and Michael Charles Albert, M.D. (Kathleen) of Severna

Park, MD; four grandchildren, Anna Virginia Leshner, Nicholas Goldsborough Leshner, William Charles Albert, and Isabel Marie Albert; five nieces; two grand-nieces; and two grand-nephews.
