



## Virginia Francis Brandolini

March 19, 1927 - November 12, 2017

Virginia Francis (Liberato) Brandolini, 90, died on November 12, 2017, of pancreatic cancer surrounded by her loving family.

Born in Bovey, MN, on March 19, 1927, she was raised in Dobbs Ferry, NY, the oldest of Harry and Rose Liberato's seven children.

During World War II, Virginia did her part by working in defense plant making radio parts for B29 bombers. As a result of the war, she met her future husband, Emilio. Following their wedding, they moved to Framingham, MA, where together they ran a shoe repair business for almost 45 years. After the sale of the shop, they moved first to Northboro, MA, then to Easton, MD.

She was a loving wife, a devoted mother and grandmother, a great cook of Italian cuisine, and a talented crocheter.

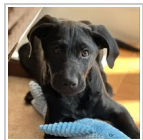
