Virginia “Ginny” Brooks Davis of Easton, MD, died Wednesday, November 6, 2013, at her home. She was 74 years old.

Born in Easton, MD, on August 20, 1939, Mrs. Davis was the daughter of the late John O. & Harriett Stevens Brooks. Mrs. Davis graduated in 1957 and worked at Waverly Press in Easton for 33 years and retired in 1990. Mrs. Davis continued working at Boyle Brothers for 10 years and then at Cutts & Case shipyard. Mrs. Davis was a member of the Eastern Shore Jousting Association, Saddle Friends, and the Women of the Moose.

Mrs. Davis is survived by her husband, Norman Lonnie Davis, Sr., of Easton; a son, Norman Lonnie Davis, Jr. (Sara); a sister, Phyllis Carroll (George); a brother, John O. Brooks, Jr. (Sherrill); one grandson, Stephan Daniel Davis; eight nephews, four nieces; many great-nephews and great-nieces; extended family by choice, Erika Mae Brady, Monica McCafferty, and Courtney Micklejohn. 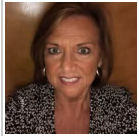
