Virginia Marie Flannery of Sudlersville, MD, died Wednesday, October 9, 2013, at her home in Sudlersville, MD. She was 92.

Mrs. Flannery was born December 11, 1920, in Lynchburg, VA, the daughter of the late, Fieldon Waggoner and Marie Pearson Waggoner. During World War II, Mrs. Flannery worked at the Navy Yard as an inspector. She later worked at the Veterans Administration, where she met her husband, Thomas L. Flannery, Sr. They married in 1947.

Mrs. Flannery lived in River Terrace, Washington, DC, and later moved to Hyattsville, MD, and Greenbelt, MD.
