



## Virginia Shockley Elliott Green

January 31, 1931 - October 25, 2013

Virginia Shockley Elliott Green died at her home surrounded by her loved ones on Friday, October 25, 2013. She was 82.

Born January 31, 1931, in Taylor's Bridge, DE, she was the daughter of the late, Eugene Franklin and Martha Foraker Shockley. In 1950, she graduated from Smyrna High School, Smyrna, DE.
