January 9, 1922 - October 2, 2013

Virginia C. Hoxter, 91, of Smyrna, DE, formerly of Grasonville, MD, passed away peacefully at her home on October 2, 2013.

Born on January 9, 1922, she was the daughter of the late Edward and Amanda Miller Cook. She grew up in Grasonville, attended Stevensville High School and married Calvert Edward Hoxter. The couple moved to Baltimore and Mrs. Hoxter became a homemaker while her husband worked in the shipyard and operated a grocery store. In the mid-1950s, the Hoxters returned to Grasonville and established Calvert Shellfish in Chester, where Mrs. Hoxter worked in the office until 1980. In 2007, she moved to Delaware to be closer to her family.

In her retirement, Mrs. Hoxter enjoyed shopping weekly with her friends, working on puzzle books, and reading. She was a member of Immanuel United Methodist Church in Grasonville.

She is survived by her son, Edward Hoxter and his wife, Patricia, of Smyrna, DE; a granddaughter, Karla Radford and her husband, Bill; and her great-grandchildren, Kayla and Sydney Radford. She was preceded in death by her husband, Calvert Hoxter, who died in 1972; her grandson, James Edward Hoxter, Jr., who died in 2001; and two siblings, Roland Miller and Evelyn Smith.

A funeral service will be held at 12 p.m. on Friday, October 4 at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. in Chester, MD, where friends may visit with the family beginning at 11 a.m.

Burial will follow in Woodlawn Memorial Park, Easton, MD.
