Virginia M. Langrell, of Easton, MD, died at Mallard Bay Nursing Home on Tuesday, June 5, 2012. She was 89.

Born in Easton, July 22, 1922, she was the daughter of the late Luther P. and Martha E. Stevens Marvel. After graduating from Easton High School in 1939 and a cosmetology school in Baltimore, she returned to Easton where she worked for several local beauticians until 1954 where she began her own business known as "The Beauty Shop." She remained active in business until retiring in 1984.

A lifelong resident of the Easton area, she was a member of the First Baptist Church of Easton.

Her husband, Richard D. Langrell, whom she married in February of 1941, died in September of 1997.

Mrs. Langrell is survived by two sons, R. Steven Langrell and his longtime companion, Lynn Whiteley of Easton; Mark D. Langrell and his wife, Kathy, of Trappe, MD; a brother, L. Everett Marvel of Easton; and a granddaughter, Sara K. Langrell, whom her grandmother took care of in her younger years; and Lynn's daughter, Tracie.

Memorial services will be held at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., in Easton, MD, on Saturday, June 9, 2012, at 11 a.m.
