



Virginia Strong Newlin

May 10, 1920 - September 8, 2024

The family of Virginia Strong Newlin sadly announces her death on Sunday, September 8, 2024, at age 104, at Heron Point in Chestertown, Maryland. She was born in Chestnut Hill, Pennsylvania and was educated at her beloved Springside School.

She was a published poet and former poet laureate of East Goshen Township in Chester County, Pennsylvania. For more than 25 years, she taught poetry and writing as an adjunct professor at the Creutzburg Center for Adult Education in Radnor, Pennsylvania. She led poetry workshops throughout her life.

Virginia was a Master Gardener and a committed environmentalist. While living in Pennsylvania, she served as a founding member of East Goshen Township's Conservancy Board for many years and actively participated in environmental programs at Hershey's Mill in West Chester, Pennsylvania and at the Brandywine Conservancy.

She held a Master of Arts in Teaching from St. John's College in Santa Fe, New Mexico. She completed a Master of Arts in Creative Writing at the Antioch International Writing Program in London England. While in England, she had several short stories broadcast by the BBC. She completed all course work for a PhD program in English Literature at Temple University.

She was always active – a sportswoman, an equestrienne, a competitive tennis, pickleball, and bocce player, and an enthusiastic participant in aerobics and yoga classes at Heron Point.

She is survived by her five children – J. Shipley Newlin, Jr., Peter Caverly Newlin, Claiborne Strong Newlin, Nina Newlin, and Alf Newlin. She was loved by her many grandchildren and great grandchildren.

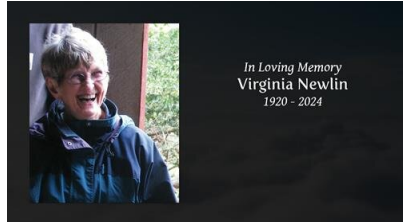
