



Virginia A. Ozman

February 3, 1929 - February 1, 2014

Virginia A. Willis Ozman of St. Michaels, died on Saturday, February 1, 2014, at the University of Maryland Medical Center in Baltimore. She was 84.

Mrs. Ozman was born on February 3, 1929, the daughter of James and Mary Willis. She was raised by Samuel J. Ireland and family.

Virginia graduated from Easton High School in 1946 and married Philip L. Ozman in 1948. She attended MacQueen-Gibbs School of Nursing at Memorial Hospital. During her working career as a nursing assistant, she was employed at House of the Pines, Home for the Aged, and at Belle Haven in Hurlock, a private care giver for multiple families in the area.

Mrs. Ozman was a popular vocalist with local groups in the 40's. She also sang in the choir at Trinity Cathedral. Virginia retired to her beloved St. Michaels, where she had many friends. She was a member of the St. Michaels Volunteer Fire Dept. Ladies Auxiliary and other local groups. Virginia was a big fan of the Baltimore Orioles.

Virginia is survived by four children, Connie Schutz of Ocean View, DE, Virginia Travers of Rhodesdale, Michael Ozman, Sr., of Easton and Catherine Ozman of Hurlock; five grandchildren, Shannon Griffith Turner, Kelley Travers Lewis, Jacob Schutz, Ashley Walls, and Michael Ozman, Jr.; and eight great-

grandchildren. In addition to her parents, she was predeceased by her husband who passed away in 1991, and a grandchild, Tammy Marie Griffith.

Funeral services will be held on Sunday, February 9, 2014, at 2 p.m. at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., 200 S. Harrison St., Easton, where friends may call from 1-2 p.m. Interment will be private.
