



## Virginia S. White

Virginia Saulsbury White, of Centreville, MD, died at Heartfields in Easton, MD, on Saturday, September 27, 2003. She was 86.

Born on a farm near Centreville, MD, on July 9, 1917, she was the third of five sisters, daughters of the late Norman B. and Lelia R. Hopkins Saulsbury. In early childhood, she moved with her family to Talbot County to the Hopkins family farm near Cordova. After graduating from Cordova High School in 1934, she attended Beacom Business College in Wilmington. She began her professional career in Baltimore at the Baltimore Coal Company.

On October 19, 1940, she married James Benjamin White, a Kent Island native. They made their home in Baltimore until after the birth of their daughter at which time they moved to a farm near Centreville known as Fairview. When her daughter started school, she returned to her business career working with Hackett and Edward Turner in Centreville for almost thirty years before retiring back to the farm.

Active in the community, she was a member of St. Paul's Episcopal Church, the Double X Homemakers, Mid-Shore Community Concerts, The Historical Society, The Kent Island Heritage Society and the Democratic Party. As an officer of the Corsica River Yacht Club, she was involved with the sailing programs and the Annual Regatta. Later, she was a member of the Kent

Island Yacht Club.

Mr. White died August 31, 1995.

Mrs. White is survived by a son, James B. White, Jr., of Gibson Island; a daughter, Sallie R. White-Bishton of Centreville; two sisters, Helen Roberts of Arlington, VA, and Jean Williams of Cordova; six grandchildren; and twelve great-grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held on Thursday, October 2 at 2 p.m. at St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Centreville.

Burial will be at Woodlawn Memorial Park in Easton.
