Upon moving to Washington DC, she was a medical secretary in an OB-Gyn office, secretary to Francis Humphrey Howard, National Library of Medicine, NIH, Bethesda, MD, secretary/administrative assistant in the office of Dr.

Vincent DeVita, Director, National Cancer Institute, NIH, Bethesda, MD, and docent for the Smithsonian Institution, Office of Education, Washington, DC.

Upon moving to Chestertown, she was secretary for the United Way of Kent County Chestertown, MD, and member of the board. She was member of the Board of Directors of CLIMB, INC., (Community Living & Independence for Multi-handicapped Blind, Inc. - formerly, MD Assoc. for Deaf, Blind & Multiple Handicapped), Board of Directors, Alumni Association, American Community School, Beirut, Lebanon, Kent County Coordinator, Eastern Shore Community Monitoring Project, League of Women Voters of Kent County, Inc., editor of the monthly newsletter, member of VOR (Voice of the Retarded), and a Governors appointment to the Holly Center Advisory Board, Salisbury, MD

There will be a memorial service held at 1 p.m. on Sunday January 20, 2002, at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home at 130 Speer Road in Chestertown.
