Virginia C Bell of Baltimore, formerly of Chester, died on Thursday, March 29, 2001 at Franklin Square Hospital. She was 88.

Born in Baltimore, MD on March 17, 1913 she was the daughter of the late Francis Jerome and Mary Edna McNaney Clifford. She graduated from Notre Dame Preparatory in Baltimore, MD in the class of 1932. Mrs. Bell married Lee G. Bell of Chester, MD on June 22, 1935; he predeceased her May 20, 1981. Mr. Bell was the first president of the Kent Island Volunteer Fire Co. Together they ran "Bell's Sales & Service" in Chester and farmed. In 1995, she moved to Oak Crest Village Retirement Community.

Mrs. Bell was a member of St. Christopher's Catholic Church in Chester, Kent Island Lions Club, Federation of Art and the Kent Island Heritage Society.

Mrs. Bell is survived by two sons: David Clifford Bell of Baltimore and Robert T. Bell of Chester; one daughter, Virginia Lee Bell Martin, of Anorage, KY; six grandchildren and four great grandchildren. Three brothers, Francis Jerome Clifford Jr., Donald Leo Clifford and Nelson Clifford predeceased her.
