



## Virginia E. Moon

May 2, 1913 - November 10, 2008

Virginia E. Moon of Cordova, MD died at Talbot Hospice House, Easton on Monday, November 10, 2008 at the age of 95.

Born May 2, 1913 in McDaniel, MD, she was the daughter of the late Arvey D. and Nina May Snively Miller. After graduating from Cordova High School in 1930, she worked on the family farm near Lewistown. On April 15, 1939, she married Leslie C. Moon, an orchard foreman for Treesdale Farms near Mars, PA, where they made their home for the next 28 years. She returned to the Cordova area to live in 1969 following her husband's death in March of 1968. She worked at Memorial Hospital at Easton in Central Supply for 11 years and thereafter as a home companion for the next five years prior to retirement.

A member of the Fairview Church of The Brethren near Cordova for many years, she has enjoyed serving as the church organist for 40 years. She also served as Deaconess and was active in the quilting group. Other interests included cooking, music, gardening, reading, traveling, and visiting family and friends. She had a loving and giving personality with a sense of humor and devotion to her family and friends. She was dearly loved and an inspiration to many people.

Mrs. Moon is survived by her daughter, Barbara M. Saulsbury and her husband Willard Merrick "Buster" Saulsbury, Jr. of Easton; a brother, A.
