Virginia "Ginnie" Green died Sunday, June 21, 2009 in Tennessee. She was 69 years old.

Born on December 30, 1939 to Mary Nickel and the late, Henry Nickel of Covington, Ohio. Mrs. Green graduated from Good Samaritan School of Nursing in Dayton, Ohio. She served 3 years as a lieutenant in the United States Air Force. On March 21, 1964 she married James Green and they resided in Whitehurst in Severna Park, MD. Mrs. Green served 2 years as a Public Health Nurse in Anne Arundel County school system. She spent 40 years as an Occupational Health Nurse and Human Resources Specialist at Westinghouse and Northrop Grumman. In 1980 they moved to Queenstown, MD.

Mrs. Green was active in the Kent Island Yacht Club and was the past president of the Kent Island Yacht Club Auxiliary. She was also a member of the American Legion, Jeff Davis Post #18.

The brightest spot in her life was the ability to act as a guiding factor in the growth and life of Glenn Iley and Jackie Iley Gallagher. She is survived by three grandchildren from that experience, Christopher Gallagher, Caitlin Iley, and Gavin Iley. She is also survived by her mother, Mary Nickel, beloved husband James Green, brothers, Ken and Charles Nickel of Ohio, and nieces
