



## Virginia Harris Bailey

March 19, 1916 - July 22, 2011

Virginia Harris Bailey of Church Hill, Maryland died on July 22, 2011 at Chester River Hospital Center in Chestertown, Maryland. She was 95.

She was born near Queenstown, Maryland the daughter of the late, Wright P. and Reba Chance Harris. Mrs. Bailey attended school in Church Hill where she made her home. She was the wife of the late, John E. Bailey, Jr. whom she married January 8, 1944. He preceded her in death on April 24, 1980.

Mrs. Bailey was an active member of the Church Hill United Methodist Church where she served on the Administrative Council, as Trustee, on the Finance Committee, and as Financial Secretary for thirty-one years. She also sang in the Church Choir. Mrs. Bailey was past president of the United Methodist Women and served her church in many other capacities. She was also a Charter member of the Church Hill Volunteer Fire Company Auxiliary where she served as Treasurer for twenty years. She was a very devout and giving member to each of these organizations.

Mrs. Bailey is survived by several cousins and close friends. In addition to her husband, she was predeceased by a sister, Evelyn H. Rieck who died April 10, 1997.
