Virginia L. Haymaker of Centreville, MD died on Monday, June 23, 2003 at Corsica Hills Nursing Home in Centreville. She was 89.

Born in Wye Mills, MD on July 3, 1913, she was the daughter of the late Erson Reed and Marjorie T. Roe Leaverton. She graduated from Centreville High School in 1930 and attended Drexel University. In 1932, she married Joseph M. Haymaker Jr. Mr. Haymaker died in July 1946 at the age of 37.

She began working with the Queen Anne's County Health Department in April 1949 and she helped with many clinics and took x-rays for 25 years. During the last 5 years of her career, she was employed in the Office of Environmental Health. She retired in 1979 after 30 years of service.

She was an active member of the Centreville United Methodist Church, she had served as secretary of the Queen Anne's County Tuberculosis Association for 15 years and was president five years and she had been a member of the Septem Homemakers' Club since it began in 1955 and was the first president of the club.

Mrs. Haymaker is survived by one son, Joseph M. Haymaker III and his wife, Ann of London, OH; a daughter, Marjorie H. Shaxted and her husband, Aldo della Coletta of Spring Grove, PA.; a sister, Maud Pippin of Queen Anne, MD

and one grandchild, Creagh B. Shawe and his wife, Patricia of Tempe, AZ. A brother, T. Roe Leaverton, died in 1980.

Funeral services will be held at the Centreville United Methodist Church in Centreville, MD on Friday, June 27, 2003 at 11AM.
