and Ginnie became a master homemaker and family rock through moves from Pennsylvania to England, to Arizona, to the top of Maine, then a final move for the couple to Lake Champlain in Plattsburgh, NY. The last few years of her life, Ginnie split her time between NY and her son's home in Maryland. Those who knew her well, knew she had a special fondness for the time she and her family lived at Fallow Corner, the thatched house in Little Bardfield, East Anglia, England.
