



Virginia W. Pfeifer

May 3, 1925 - March 31, 2011

Virginia Walker Pfeifer died on March 31, 2011. She was 85.

Born in Washington, DC on May 3, 1925, she was the daughter of the late Robert Craighead Walker and Dorothy van der Veer Walker. She attended school in Scarsdale and Bronxville, New York. She continued her education and graduated from Dunbarton College of Holy Cross in 1947. On September 10, 1949, she married Joseph William Pfeifer and resided in Washington, DC until moving to Chevy Chase, Maryland in 1963. In 1996, Virginia and her husband moved to the Eastern Shore of Maryland, residing in Easton.

Mrs. Pfeifer was a member of the Women's Guild at Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Church. She enjoyed visits from her children and grandchildren, and traveling.
