Virginia Woodall Hebb, a Maryland native, died on October 31, 2002 at Heart Fields in Easton, MD.

Born in Crumpton, MD on October 18, 1915, she was the daughter of the late George Warfield and Grace Biddle Woodall. The Woodalls raised their family in Kenton, DE. On October 15, 1939 she married Charles Parish Hebb of Baltimore and they resided in the Guilford area of Baltimore City. She worked for many years at the American Heart Association in Baltimore. Mr. Hebb owned and operated both Ideal Transer and Hebb Produce Co., he died on December 24, 1991.
