Vivian Delores Garnett of Pondtown, MD, went to be with the lord on Tuesday July 12, 2016 at her home in Pondtown. She was 80.

Vivian D. Garnett was born August 2, 1935 in Pondtown, MD the daughter of the late John Ashley and Mae "Fletcher" Ashley. Mrs. Garnett was a 1953 graduate of Kennard High School. She continued her education and graduated from the University of Maryland Eastern Shore. After several years of substitute teaching, Vivian received her teaching degree and went to work for Queen Anne's County School system where she taught for 28 years. Mrs. Garnett was a very active member of Mt. Pleasant United Methodist Church in Pondtown and the Martin Luther King Foundation. She enjoyed bowling, playing softball, and speaking for churches.
