



Vivian Angela Putnam

July 7, 1915 - August 14, 2012

Vivian Angela Putnam of Chestertown, MD, died on Wednesday, August 14, 2012, at William Hill Gardens in Easton, MD. She was 97.

Mrs. Putnam was born on July 7, 1915, in Toronto, Canada. She was the daughter of the late Dr. William James McCormick and Dr. Florence Ellen DeLhorbe McCormick. After graduation from high school, she continued her education at the Western Business College in Toronto and became employed by the Confederation Life Insurance Company.

In 1941 she married Donald Fleming Putnam. When her husband enlisted in the American Army, Mrs. Putnam began working for Dr. Drury, Director of Metallurgy, Department of Munitions and Supply in Toronto. She moved to Baltimore, MD, to join her husband when he was commissioned as a Lieutenant in the Army. They resided at Edgewood Arsenal. After the end of World War II, Mrs. Putnam moved with her husband and family to Scotia, NY, where they lived until retiring to Chestertown, MD, in 1998.

Mrs. Putnam was an accomplished swimmer and diver, receiving metals for her achievements. She was also an avid bridge player and belonged to the American Contract Bridge League, winning many trophies in competition.

In addition to her parents and her husband, she was predeceased by her

sisters, Helen Stannard and Constance McKay, and a brother, John McCormick.

Mrs. Putnam is survived by her daughters, Susan Kerns of Chestertown, MD, and Janet Sennett and husband, Paul of Lewes, DE; and a grandson, Bryon Lockhart and wife, Jennifer and their children, Noah, Micah, Hannah, Ezra, Gabriella and Alaythia.

Services will be held privately. Interment will be in Shrewsbury Cemetery, Kennedyville, MD.
