A dedicated student with a passion for learning, Vivien graduated from the National University of San Agustín in Arequipa, Peru, where she earned her master's degree in accounting. Her education laid the foundation for a life marked by diligence, integrity, and professional excellence.

In 2010, Vivien married the love of her life, Alfredo, and together they made their home in Easton, Maryland. United by their shared dreams and entrepreneurial spirit, they established El Dorado, a beloved Hispanic restaurant that became a gathering place for family, friends, and the local community. As owner and manager, Vivien devoted herself to her work with warmth, hospitality, and kindness until her passing.

Vivien had a deep appreciation for God's creation and cherished the opportunity to travel the world. Her journeys took her to Italy, France, Spain, Croatia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Colombia, Peru, and Mexico. 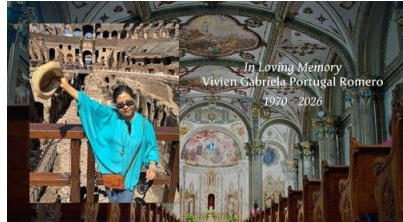

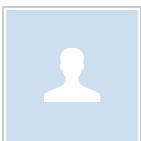
