Vivien was one of my all time favorite people. She always had a smile and kind word for everyone, and she always seemed to be genuinely interested in her friends and their lives. I have four daughters whose names all start with "A" and Vivien always remembered them as well as the two grandchildren of mine that she met.

I introduced Vivien to scrapbooking at a workshop at my home. When I started showing everyone how to crop photos to make them better, she said she could never cut hers! I particularly enjoyed the one she did about their trip to Poland to meet his family members that the priest had put him in touch with. It was her pictures of Butchart Gardens that made me put that trip on my bucket list. I was so happy when I could send Vivien a postcard from there, not once, but twice!!

I am so sad to know that my friend has left this earth, but will remember her for years to come and be thankful that our paths crossed and intertwined for a while.
