



## Wade F. Teves

November 18, 1930 - January 3, 2014

Wade F. Teves, Jr., died on January 3, 2014, at Hospice Center in Centreville, MD. He was 83.

Born on November 18, 1930, in Baltimore, MD, to the late Wade F. Teves and Irene A. Holmes Teves. He attended school in Baltimore. On December 24, 1949, he married Joan T. Montgomery and resided in Baltimore. In 1952, Mr. Teves became a police officer with the Baltimore City Police Department. In 1973, he retired from the Baltimore City Police Department's Marine Division. That same year, he began working with Hale Containers as a tug Boat Engineer. For 10 years, Mr. Teves worked up and down the Chesapeake Bay and the East Coast.

Mr. Teves, with his wife, Joan; had five children, Connie L. Teves, Wade F. Teves, III, George R. Teves, Joan E. Teves and Diane C. (Teves) Vranas; eight grandchildren; Kathleen J. Mr. Teves has two brothers that predeceased him, Holmes H. Teves and Vernon C. W. Teves.
