



## Walda Gertrude Elliott

August 24, 1939 - April 6, 2012

Walda Gertrude Elliott of Queenstown died at the Hospice of Queen Anne's, Inc. on Friday April 6, 2012 of congestive heart failure. She was 72 years old. Walda was born August 24, 1939 to William Walter Denny Sr. and Pocahontas Denny.
