



## Walker Cree Eliason

December 2, 1928 - December 15, 2016

James Walker Cree Eliason of Chestertown, MD, died on December 15, 2016.

Born in 1928, he was the son of the late Thomas W. Eliason, Sr. and Marguerite Cree Eliason. He was predeceased by his first wife of forty years, Elizabeth Ann Smith Eliason, who died in 1999; his second wife of twelve years, Joan Marie Rule Eliason, who passed away in 2014; his son, James Cree Eliason; his sister, Mary Margaret Eliason Hoopes Forney; brothers, Thomas W. Eliason, Jr., John Cree Eliason, and Alan Eliason. He is survived by his granddaughter, Aimee M. Eliason of Baltimore; a brother, David Eliason of CA; and many nieces and nephews.

Walker attended public schools in Chestertown, the Mercersburg Academy in Pennsylvania, and received a BSc degree at the University of Maryland in 1957.

He served in the United States Air Force for three years in NJ, ID, and the Philippines. He had employments with the Kent County Savings Bank and the LaMotte Chemical Products Company. For twenty years, he operated a charter and flight instruction business.

Joining the Chestertown Fire Company in 1944, Mr. Eliason subsequently served in the Active Firefighting Service. He held various administrative

positions, including the office of Treasurer, Chairman of the New Truck Fund and the Investment Committee. He also served on the Board of Directors and was a Life Member of the Company.

In earlier years, Mr. Eliason was affiliated with Troop 130 of the Boy Scouts of America and later he was active with the Junior Fireman program and the Explorer Post of the Chestertown Volunteer Fire Company. He was a member of the Frank M. Jarman Post #36 American Legion and served as Treasurer of the First United Methodist Church in Chestertown, of which he was a member.

Burial will be private in Chester Cemetery and a memorial service will be held at a future date to be announced.
