STEVENSVILLE: Wallace Maloy Barnes of Stevensville died Friday, June 20, 2003 at his home. He was 77.

Born on September 13, 1925 in Baltimore, MD, Mr. Barnes was the son of the late Robert Stanley Barnes and Beulah Lenore Patterson Barnes. Mr. Barnes served in the United States Navy during World War II in the Pacific Theater. On November 22, 1946 he married Janice C. Camp of Newark, N.J. Upon returning home from the war, he went to work for American Can Company of Baltimore, MD, and retired in March 1983 as a superintendent with 38 years of service. In 1968 he and his wife moved to the Eastern Shore residing in Stevensville.
