February 3, 1918 - December 23, 2014

Wallace John Gilbert “Stubby” of Stevensville, MD, died on December 23, 2014, at his home. He was 96.

Born on February 3, 1918, in Haydensville, MA, to the late Frank Joseph Gilbert and Susie Champlain Gilbert, he grew up in the Narragansett, RI area. He was a commercial fisherman for 35 years, before moving to Maryland where he captained a research vessel for Johns Hopkins University.

He loved playing all card games and reading. Watching his family grow, picking vegetables and playing ball in the yard, and visiting relatives out of state gave him great pleasure.

He is survived by his daughter, Dorothy Ann Mikaelian (Harry) of Dayville, CT; son, John Gilbert (Wyna) of Stevensville, MD; daughter, Elizabeth Miles (Rodney) of Stevensville, MD; son, Richard William Harris (Theresa) of Charleston, SC; 11 grandchildren; 32 great grandchildren; 2 great-great grandchildren; sister Marion Gilbert Smith of Stevensville, MD; and sister Grace Jordan of FL.
