Wallace Elmer Thompson of Easton, MD died on Thursday, August 26, 2004 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 87.

Born in Magnolia, DE, August 14, 1917, he was the son of the late James E. and Molly Hughes Thompson. After attending public school, he worked for the family fruit business and then for Glenn L. Martin in Baltimore before serving in the U.S. Army during World War II. He served in the European Theatre of Operations in the Southern France Campaign, where he was wounded October 29, 1944, for which he earned a Purple Heart. Following his release from active duty in May 1945 he was associated with his brother, George Thompson, in the operation of Thompson Motors in Easton until retiring in 1994.

A resident of Easton since 1945, he was a member of E.E. Streets Memorial Post 5118 V.F.W., Easton.

Mr. Thompson is survived by his wife, the former Catherine Hardy, whom he married July 31, 1943; a son, Wallace E. Thompson of Lewes, DE and a grandson, Casey T. Thompson of Ocean City, MD.

Funeral services will be held at the graveside at Camden Odd Fellows, Cemetery, Camden, DE on Monday, August 30, 2004 at 2:00 PM.
