Walter Evan Davis of Stevensville, MD died Tuesday, May 27, 2003 at Anne Arundel Medical Center in Annapolis, MD. He was 77.

Born on March 14, 1926 in Allentown, PA where he spent his youth. He later moved to Cumberland, MD and enlisted on the G.I. Bill serving in Army Air Corp. After honorable discharge from the Corp., he attended Fairmont College where he received his BS degree in Education. Mr. Davis would later teach at Centreville High School as a physical education teacher where he met and married his wife the former, Grace Baker, in 1952. He would later go to work for the Veteran's Administration as hospital administrator. Walter and Grace would later move to Baltimore and then to Erie, PA and then returned to Baltimore. He retired as chief of administration for the VA Hospital in 1983 and relocated to the Eastern Shore. In addition to his many accomplishments, he was known for being an avid bowler and golfer.
