



## Walter Lobb Geggis

January 2, 1941 - August 21, 2013

Walter Lobb Geggis of Centreville, MD, died at the UMSMC at Easton on Wednesday, August 21, 2013. He was 72.

Born January 2, 1941, in Bryn Mawr, PA, he was the son of the late William John and Miriam Lobb Geggis. He graduated from The Episcopal Academy in 1958 and from the School of Hotel Management at Cornell University in 1963.

Mr. Geggis is survived by his wife, the former, Judith Ewing, whom he married in 1978; two daughters, Andrea Geggis Forsyth and her husband Jeff of Mebane, NC and Mary Kimberley Cantrell of Linwood, NJ; a sister, May Geggis Holgren and her husband Clifford of Bryn Mawr, PA; and one grandchild, Connor Michael Forsyth.

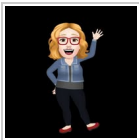
