Walter Dennis Messick of Chestertown, MD, died on April 12, 2022, at Anne Arundel Medical Center in Annapolis. He was 66 years old.

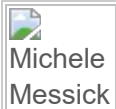

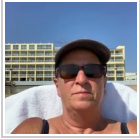
