Walter "Walt" Charles Muth died Tuesday, July 13, 2004 at Upper Chesapeake Medical Center. He was 70.

Born August 3, 1934 in Rock Hall, MD, he was the son of the late George William and Katharine Ema Briers Muth. He graduated from Rock Hall High School and following graduation, he enlisted in the army for 3 years working in the water treatment field, as well as in the field of demolitions and explosives and then enlisted in the air force for 2 years working in electronics.
