Walter Owen Rodney, a lifelong resident of Rock Hall, MD died on Sunday, March 3, 2002 at the Chestertown Nursing and Rehabilitation Center. He was 86.

Born in Rock Hall, MD on December 20, 1915, he was the son of the late Walter Reuben and Lillian Myrtle Warner Rodney.

Mr. Rodney was a 1932 graduate of Rock Hall High School and a 1934 graduate of Goldy Beacom Business School in Delaware. On March 19, 1938 he married Jean Leary, they continued to reside in Rock Hall, MD. Mr. Rodney worked for A & P Grocery Store in Rock Hall, MD which was owned by his father. In March of 1943 he enlisted in the U.S. Army and served in the European Theatre during WWII. He was honorably discharged in February of 1946, and returned to Rock Hall. Mr. Rodney once again worked with his father at the A & P, then with the Kelsh Percision Plant as a lathe operator. He later worked with the Rock Hall Marine Railway from which he retired in 1977.

Mr. Rodney was a member of Rock Hall Vol. Fire Dept., a 55 year member of Sgt. Preston Ashley American Legion Post #228 in Rock Hall, Md. and a 55 year member of Chester Lodge # 115 A.F.& A.M. He enjoyed carpentry, baseball, and music.

In addition to his wife of 63 years, he is survived by a daughter, Elizabeth

“Betty” Johnston of Derwood, MD; a grandson, Roger Woolford of Rootstown, OH; and 4 great grandchildren.
