Walter "Moose" Ward of Easton, MD, formerly of Baltimore, died on Sunday, September 30, 2007 at Calvert Memorial Hospital, Prince Frederick, MD. He was 83.

Born May 25, 1924 in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late George J. and Mary Hixenbaugh Ward. During World War II and the Korean Conflict, he served in the United States Marine Corps. For thirty-five years he worked for Waverly Press in Baltimore and Easton, retiring in 1985.

His wife, the former Peg Cooper, whom he married December 17, 1950, died March 20, 2001.

He was a member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church, Past Exalted Ruler of B.P.O. Easton Elks Lodge #1622, a member of Liberty Lodge #219 AF&AM, and a member of the Shriners.

Mr. Ward is survived by two children, Brenda Coyne of Baltimore, MD and W. Lee Ward of Dayton, VA; a sister, Shirley Taylor of Easton, MD; four grandchildren, Andrew Bounds, Adam Coyne, Brooks Ward and Sarah Ward; and two great-grandchildren, Grace and Jordan Bounds. He was predeceased by a brother, Bill Ward who died in 2003.

Funeral services will be held on Friday, October 5, 2007 at 11:00 AM at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, MD. Friends may call at the funeral home on Thursday evening from 6 to 8 PM where an Elks Memorial Service will begin at 7:45 PM
