



## Walter Albert Seaman

May 23, 1921 - February 24, 2011

Walter Albert Seaman of Queenstown, MD died on Thursday, February 24, 2011 at the Hospice Center of Queen Anne's, Centreville, MD. He was 89.

Born May 23, 1921 in Port Chester, NY, he was the son of the late, George Anderegg and Blanche Estelle Moslander Seaman. He graduated from Greenwich Community High School in the Class of 1939. He later joined the U.S. Navy in February 1942 and served in the Atlantic and Pacific Theatres during World War II as an aviation machinists mate First Class. Following his release from active duty he worked as an aircraft mechanic. Later he worked in Stratford, CT as an aircraft engine inspector for the Civil Service U.S. Air Force and then on to work for the Defense Logistic Agency in Buffalo, NY. On November 24, 1956 he married Martha J. Bassett of Warrior, AL. Following his retirement in Sept. 1987 as Chief of Quality Assurance Division in Stratford, CT they moved to Stevensville, MD and later to Queenstown, MD.

He was a member of the American Society for Quality Control and the Society for Reliability Engineers, member of St. Luke's Episcopal Church, Queenstown, MD and the VFW in Grasonville, MD.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Seaman is survived by three daughters, Kim Louise Niland and Lisa Anne Seaman-Crawford, both of Arnold, MD and Donna Lynne Hollis of Troy, VA; a sister, Doris Estelle Hayden of Sugarland, TX and

nine grandchildren, Ryan and Jamie Niland, Brett, Evan and Rachel Crawford, Andrew, Alexandria, Jacob and Noah Hollis.

Funeral services will be held at St. Luke's Episcopal Church, Queenstown, MD on Tuesday, March 1, 2011 at 11:00 AM.

Burial will be at Crownsville Veteran Cemetery, Crownsville, MD at 1:00 PM.
