Walter Lee Brink passed away on Sunday, December 9, 2007 at the Corsica Hills Nursing Home, surrounded by his loving family. He was 86 years old. He is predeceased by his wife of 59 years, Margaret (Buddy) Brink.

Walter was born on March 21, 1921 in Sioux City, Iowa. He served in the U.S. Army Air Corps during WWII. After being honorably discharged, Walter spent his working life in the automobile and music businesses. He was an accomplished musician playing both the tuba and the string bass. He served on the board of directors of the national organization for several years. He helped many local hams get their licenses and establish their stations.
