



Walter R. Lindquist

December 6, 1923 - November 23, 2010

Walter R. Lindquist died at the Memorial Hospital in Easton on November 23, 2010. He was 86.

Born in Worcester, MA on December 6, 1923, he was the son of Clarence and Florence Brunelle Lindquist. After graduating from Western High School in Washington, DC, Mr. Lindquist earned a Bachelor's of Science Degree from the University of Maryland, where he was also a member of the Scabbard & Blades Society, the Arnold Society, and the Boxing team. Mr. Lindquist served in the Naval Submarine Service in the North Atlantic, during which time he was an active participant in boxing and softball programs. After his military service, he owned and operated the Tri-County Gasoline and Oil Corporation, which was based in Christiansburg, VA.

Mr. Lindquist enjoyed piloting his own plane, rebuilding cars, round and square dancing, and playing poker and bridge. He was a member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church in Easton.

He is survived by his devoted wife of 62 years, Gloria S. Lindquist; his children, Debbie Wilson (Kevin) of Stevensville, and Bill Lindquist of Absecon, NJ; his grandchildren: Ben Wilson, Kara Lindquist, and Mackenzie Lindquist; and his sister, Florence Johnson of Pompano Beach, FL. In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by his sister, Shirley Schutt.

A memorial service will be held at 11:00 am on Saturday, December 4 at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. in Easton, where friends may call one hour prior to the service.

Interment will be private.
