Walter Trapnell Denny, a lifelong resident of Kent Island, died at Anne Arundel Medical Center on Monday, September 22, 2008 after a lengthy illness. He was 69 years old.

Mr. Denny was born on Scillin Farm in Stevensville, MD on April 30, 1939 to the late Thomas Walter Denny and Emily Peale Roe Denny. While growing up on the farm, he developed a lifelong passion for agriculture. After graduating from Stevensville High School, Class of 1957, Mr. Denny went on to graduate from the University of Maryland with a Bachelor of Science degree in agriculture. He worked for over 40 years as an Entomologist for the U.S. Department of Agriculture. Upon retirement, his passions included country living, country music and genealogy.
