July 21, 1941 - January 17, 2013

Wanda Louise Stansbury of St. Michaels, MD, died at Johns Hopkins Bayview on Thursday, January 17, 2013. She was 71.

Wanda L. Stansbury was born July 21, 1941, in Summerlee, WV, the daughter of the late James Bennett and Della "Young" Bennett. Mrs. Stansbury married on December 23, 1963, to Richard Jerome Stansbury and together, they raised their family. Mrs. Stansbury was a big supporter of the St. Jude's Children's Hospital.
