



## Warren B. McGinnis

October 4, 1941 - June 12, 2011

Warren B. McGinnis of Chestertown, MD passed away on Sunday, June 12, 2011 at his home, surrounded by his loving family, after a long battle with Cancer and Leukemia. He was 69 years old.

Mr. McGinnis was born on October 4, 1941 in Chestertown, MD. He was the son of the late Paul B. McGinnis and Mary Isabelle Jones McGinnis of Chestertown, MD. He began driving a paper route when he was 16 and continued through school. In the late 60's and early 70's, he delivered petroleum products for D & R Supply Company in Chestertown, MD. He became a professional driver for Overnight Transportation for 9 years. He then began driving for Air Products & Chemical until his retirement in 2004.

Mr. McGinnis was a life member of the Chestertown Volunteer Fire Company where he served in the Chief Engineer position for over 20 years. He served as a firefighter and an engineer for most of his 50 plus years of his volunteer service.

In addition to his mother, he is survived by his wife of 16 years, Nancy McGinnis, a daughter; Melissa Michelle Rhodes of Chestertown, MD, a son; Michael Todd McGinnis of Chestertown, MD, a step-daughter; Georgette Angel Mercer of Chestertown, MD, six grandchildren; Gregory Rhodes, Brandon McGinnis, Michael McGinnis, Kendall McGinnis, Tommy Mercer and Serena Jones, three sisters; Wilma Seaman and husband Ronnie of Woodside, DE, Mary Jo Gardner and husband Kenny of North Carolina, and Joyce Ann Coleman and husband Jerry of Chestertown, MD, and two
