A Funeral Liturgy for Warren V. Callahan of Easton, MD will be celebrated on Tuesday, February 15, 2005 at 12:00 Noon at Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church, Easton, MD. Mr. Callahan passed away on Thursday, February 10, 2005 at Talbot Hospice House, Easton. He was 80.

Born May 20, 1924 at Wye Landing, he was the son of the late Valiant V. and Lelia Callahan Callahan. He attended public school in Talbot County and then worked for Kenersly Dairy Farm and was then a manager for Sealtest Dairies. Following his retirement from Sealtest, he was a bus contractor for the Talbot County School System and also worked part-time for UPS until his retirement from both.

Mr. Callahan's wife, the former Helen Councell, whom he married February 21, 1946, died on June 16, 1997.

A member of Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church, he was also a member of the Regina Coeli Council Knights of Columbus 2274.

Mr. Callahan is survived by three daughters, Mary Lou Barrow and her husband Dick, Carol P. Mulder and her companion Dirk Dekker and Frances C. Murn and her husband Thomas, all of Easton; one sister, Patricia Lonquist of Bear, DE; two grandchildren, Erik Mulder and Heather Foote; four great-

grandchildren, E.J., Coty, Victoria and T.Q.. He was predeceased by two sisters, Anna Dulin and Jean Dulin; and one brother, Bobby Callahan.
