Wayman Warren Sinclair, of Cordova, MD and formerly of Tilghman, MD died at Talbot Hospice House, Easton on Thursday, July 5, 2001. He was 85.

Born in McDaniel, August 17, 1915, he was the son of the late Beecher T. and Mary Wilson Sinclair. After attending public school, he, in 1935, began a forty-year career with the Tilghman Packing Company at Tilghman. At the time of the plant's closing in 1975, he was the Plant Engineer. He then worked for the Town of St. Michaels as head of the Equipment and Maintenance Department until retiring in 1984 for health reasons.

A resident of Cordova since 1988, he moved there from Tilghman where he had been in charge of the maintenance of Kronsberg Park in Tilghman from its opening in the 1960's until moving to Cordova. He was also an active member of the Tilghman United Methodist Church where he had served on many committees and boards.

Mr. Sinclair is survived by, his wife, the former Fay Cooper whom he married in 1961 in Tilghman, MD; a daughter, Cynthia J. Shipley and her husband, Charles, of Cordova, MD and one granddaughter, BM1 Robin N. Shipley, U.S.C.G. of Staten Island, N. Y. Two sisters, May S. Stone and Mildred S. Palmer and a brother, Luther Sinclair, are deceased.

Memorial services will be held on Monday, July 9, 2001 at 11:00 AM at the Tilghman United Methodist Church, Tilghman followed by a reception at the church. Burial will be private.
