Wayne Evans Reeser, 83, passed away on June 14, 2018, at his home, after a long battle with diabetes.

He was born on September 16, 1934, on Tilghman Island, the fifth son of the late Dr. Guy Reeser and Roberta Price Reeser.

Wayne grew up on Tilghman and graduated from St. Michaels High School in 1952. At seventeen, he enlisted in the United States Air Force and served honorably for four years during the Korean War. After the war, he was employed as a pressman at Waverly Press for 40 years.

Upon retirement, he earned his Charter Boat Captain's License and enjoyed taking out fishing parties for five years. Wayne knew where the fish were hiding and always got his limit! He often said that watching the sun rise and set on the Chesapeake Bay was the next thing to Heaven. Next to fishing, Wayne loved to play golf, especially with his golfing buddies, Dave, Page, Tom and Willey. He was a member of the VFW# 5118 and the Easton Elks Club # 1622.

On June 14, 1981, he married Mary E. Allspach and moved to Easton. They enjoyed traveling and were able to visit Ireland, Canada, Mexico, as well as many places in the U.S.

Wayne was a family man and was loved by his wife, Mary Reeser and his children, Tom Reeser of Berlin, MD, Wayne E. Reeser and wife, Kathy of Gambrills, MD, Jean Player Walters and husband, Ron of Dickson, TN; as well as his stepdaughters, Laura Ambler and husband Cary of Easton, MD, and Julie Alley and husband Blair of Easton, MD; grandchildren who were all dear to him, Heather, Tommy, Sean, Brittany, Nathan, Ashley, Erin, Sam and Joe.

He was preceded in death by his four brothers, Dr. Guy Reeser, George (Bob) Reeser, Ted Reeser and Henry Reeser.
