W. Donald "Woody" Wood, Sr. of Easton, MD died on Thursday, November 6, 2008 at Genesis Health Care – The Pines, Easton. He was 62.

Born in Easton, September 30, 1946, he was the son of the late Earle B. and Frances Moore Wood. Following graduation from Easton High School he worked at various jobs. He later started Aqua Pools with his partner and co-founder, Dave Kibler. After the sale of that business, he formed Shore Pool Care where he remained until retiring for health reasons.

He was always very proud that as a young man he was a Boy Scout who achieved the designation of Eagle Scout. A lifelong resident of Easton, he was a member of B.P.O. Easton Elks #1622, American Legion Post #70, and Easton Moose Lodge #1520.

Mr. Wood is survived by his wife, the former Nancy Phillips; four children, W. Donald Wood, Jr., John Andrew of Monterey CA, Roger Ruby of Newcomb, MD, and Holly Ruby of Cambridge, MD; two sisters, Sue Turner of Easton, and Ellen Wood Walmsley of Chestertown; two brothers, Earle B.
