



## W. Ellsworth Cadell

January 28, 1915 - March 9, 2011

Willard Ellsworth Cadell died Wednesday, March 9, 2011 in Easton, MD. He was 96.

Born in Catonsville, MD on January 28, 1915, the son of the late Willard and Elizabeth Cadell (nee Diehlman), he lived in Catonsville until 1989 when he moved to St. Michaels, MD. For the past 10 years he has resided at William Hill Manor in Easton.

A graduate of Catonsville High School and Loyola University (College), Ellsworth served proudly in the United States Coast Guard during World War II. As a member of "the greatest generation", he served in actions in North Africa, Sicily, Anzio, Salerno and took part in the D-Day invasion at Omaha Beach, Normandy on June 6, 1944. He retired from the United States Coast Guard Reserves as a full Commander.

Ellsworth was an enthusiastic gardener and received much acclaim for his beautiful roses and freely provided gardening advice. He served as a volunteer with Meals on Wheels in the Baltimore County area. He was a member of St. Luke's United Methodist Church, St. Michaels.

He is survived by his wife of 62 years, Margaret (Peggy) Spry Cadell of Easton; daughter Leslie Bowie and husband, Bill of Williamsburg, VA; son

David Cadell and wife, Wendy of Easton; and grandson Morgan Cadell of Easton.

In addition to his parents, Ellsworth was preceded in death by his brother, Carroll Cadell and sister, Edna Cadell Magness.

A memorial service will be held on Saturday, March 12, 2011 at 1 p.m. in the auditorium of William Hill Manor, 501 Dutchmans Lane, Easton, MD.

Burial is scheduled for a later date at the Maryland Eastern Shore Veterans Cemetery in Hurlock, MD.
